Entries Close at 4:00pm Friday 15th October 2010. The organisers reserve the right to refuse late entries and entries will not be accepted unless accompanied by the \$40.00 entry fee (\$10 for minors under 15).

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. DRESS** Long Sleeves and long pants must be worn at all times
- 2. WHEELS** Each cart must have 3 or 4 wheels with minimum 20 inch diameter
- 3. CREW** A cart crew must consist of two people, who may change position on the cart, however, one person must remain wholly on the cart at all times whilst the cart is in motion. All crew must be at least 15 years of age.
- 4. TIMES** Race commences at 11:30am. All competitors must be at the starting line by 10:30am.
- 5. HELMETS** Each crew member must wear a full face crash helmet properly fastened.
- 6. PROPULSION** Will be free-wheeling with one crew member pushing when required. Any other means of propulsion will lead to automatic disqualification.
- 7. CARTS** Any cart considered unsuitable for safety reasons, or not considered categorised as a Billycart may be withdrawn from the race prior to the start by the committee representatives and no money will be refunded.
- 8. BRAKES** Each cart must be fitted with an adequate braking system on each rear wheel and deemed to be satisfactory by the race organisers. Carts fitted with caliper type brakes only will not be accepted.
- 9. PROTRUDING EDGES** Carts may be deemed unsafe if sharp or protruding edges are not removed or suitably padded.
- 10. NUMBERS** Provision must be made on carts for a number. 23cm white square on the front, and both sides of the cart. Numbers will be allocated after the draw on the Saturday preceding the race.
- 11. CLASSES**
 - A. OPEN CART CLASS: Carts must not have sides higher than 500mm from the floor of the cart and no screens.
 - B. FOUR-WHEEL CLASS: Carts must have 4 wheels and may be open or enclosed.
 - C. PRO-CART CLASS: Carts may be fully enclosed and have 3 or 4 wheels.
